Through the SSDN Local Infrastructure Hub (LIH) Southeast Regional Cohort Program, local governments and community-based organizations (CBOs) are eligible for:

- Expert-led technical assistance to pursue federal funding opportunities
- Direct funding to support CBOs' climate and racial equity work up to \$30,000
- Combined technical assistance and funding support for CBOs up to \$20,000

Step 1: Download your application
