2. Entity Registration

SAM.gov - Intro



- System for **A**ward **M**anagement
- **U**nique **E**ntity **I**D: 12 alphanumeric characters
 - Replaces the DUNS Number
- Validates existence of your entity
- Entity Validation Service may take a few days
- Entity Administrator/EBiz Point of Contact

SAM.gov - Registration

- Must be authorized to conduct business on behalf of entity
- Sign in with Login.gov account, if already have one
- Info needed:
 - Legal business name
 - Physical address
 - Year of incorporation/start year
 - State of incorporation

SAM.gov - Troubleshooting

- Verify if your entity is registered
 - Requires a login
- Locked out of the account (personnel change, lost password)
 - Submit an Entity Administrator Appointment Letter
 - Federal Service Desk: FSD.gov (same login as SAM)
 - Select “Create an Incident”

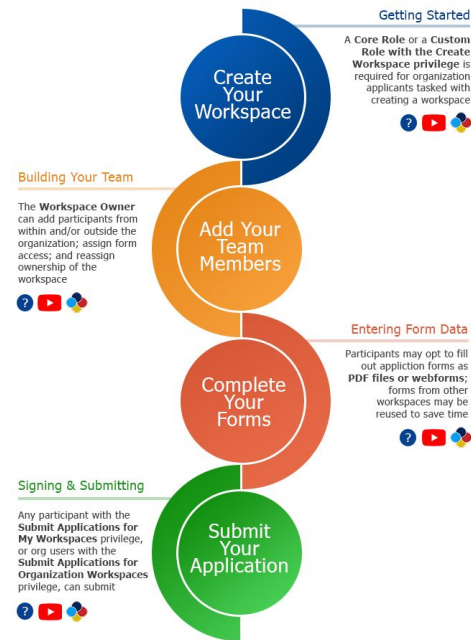
